***Faith Facts II: Answers to Catholic Questions***, edited by Leon J. Suprenant, Jr. and Philip C. L. Gray, provides clear answers to questions about Church teaching and how it applies to current events. ***Prophets and Apostles: A “Come and See” Catholic Bible Study*** takes a refreshingly direct and engaging approach to the study of Scripture. Authors Fr. Joseph Ponessa and Laurie Manhardt, Ph.D., have developed an interactive, user-friendly study that combines the “old” and the “new”—covering eleven prophets of the Old Testament and five apostles of the New Testament.
