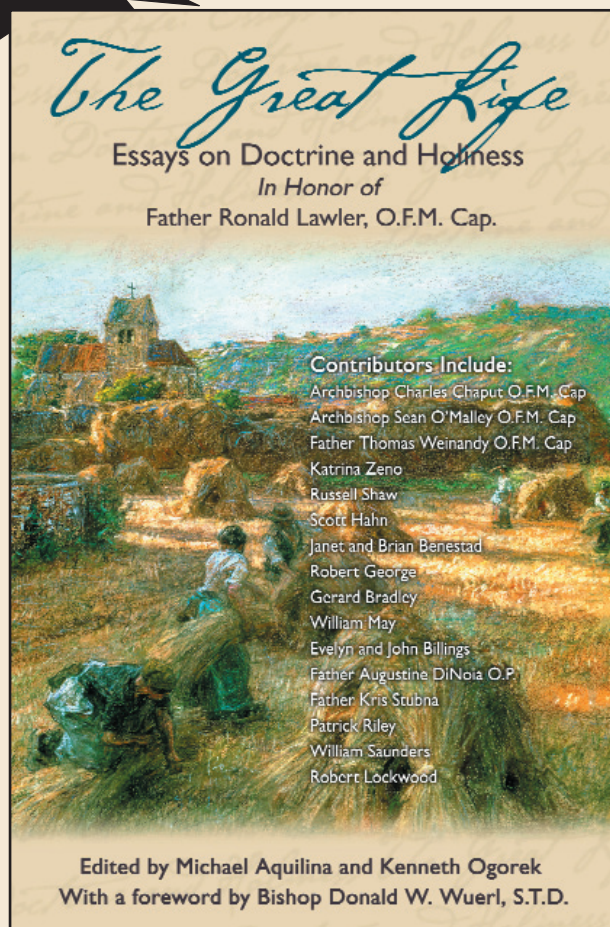


The Great Life
